

When did you realize that you needed to step out of your comfort zone to level up to where you are today?

When I took a contract with Proctor & Gamble to work in their South Africa division for months at a time.

What has been a turning point in the beauty industry in your opinion?

The era of social media and youtube and how it has changed educational perspectives in the industry in negative ways.

Can you offer advice or tips for stylists trying to get into the education side of the industry?

If you're gonna teach, get training first. Don't let your ability to do hair really well, give you a false sense that it qualifies you to teach.

What is the best way to cover / camouflage gray?

Formulation! Analyze the percentage of gray...match it level for level (10% of gray formula to 10% gray for example) with the same amount of gray formula at 1 to 2 levels higher than the level you're working at. Use this approach up to 50% of gray. Anything over 50%, stay at 50% of gray formula (50% and over only requires 50% of gray formula included in regular or total formula. This is guaranteed gray coverage or camouflage.

Would you recommend something different for a client who is wanting to let the gray grow in but not look unkept?

After shampoos, use a mixture of 2 part moisturizing conditioner and 1 part 20 volume peroxide as the conditioner for about 3 minutes.

Talent or knowledge not being a factor, and you weren't a beauty professional, what career would you have?

Politician.

My very own retreat which is going into its second annual year entitled "Hairdressers Empowerment Retreat".
